Old Business: Greg gave an update to the board about the annual CACD/NACD meeting which took place in September in Golden. Both Greg and Marisa gave presentations to the attendees. Marisa's evaluation will be addressed in an executive session. Marisa will present the board with a job description for the board to post. The district annual meeting will be postponed until March of 2026 due to the uncertainty of when the government will open again so that we can have our federal partners participate. There was discussion about the board having a letter or brochure for homeowners regarding disturbed soil. Greg shared an Iowa State Emergency Management booklet that he found at the CACD annual meeting. This might be a good topic for the annual meeting next March.

New Business: Marisa presented the board with a draft 2026 budget. The 2026 budget will be finalized at the December 2025 meeting and voted on then.

Wendy: Wendy reported that Palmer Land Trust came out to their land for their conservation easement review. They are using Google Earth now instead of walking the whole property. Park County is revisiting their STR guidelines, and I believe that she said that a tax will be on their ballot. Teller County has completed the first round of meetings, and the consultant is compiling the data that was collected during that process. They will then choose 20 topics and then there

will be a new set of meetings. The planning department is interviewing possible new members. There will be one new board member and one alternate.

Dave: Dave spoke with the Park County Fair Board, and they have said that they are aware that their auction process can be confusing. He is hopeful that changes will be made. He also filled in on the backlog of bureaucracy regarding getting on the CPW list for future wolf depredation claims. They are understaffed and underfunded. He is still waiting for a site assessment to get the ball rolling. He is on the board of directors of the Colorado Cattleman's Trust. He let us know that there is legislation being developed that would potentially allow fisherman to fish even on private streams. Private lands are integral to wildlife management.

Greg: Greg shared thank you cards from some of the Teller County 4-H livestock kids. Greg informed the board that Governor Polis has placed an emphasis on recreational activities taking place on or near Pikes Peak. The Teller County Board of Commissioners has concerns that a lot of that activity would take place in Teller County and they are worried about restrooms, trash, maintaining trailheads, law enforcement and search and rescue and the impact it could have on Teller County residents. One third of all EMS calls are from out-of-area residents.

Executive Session: The board went into executive session at 12:10 PM. The board came out of executive session at 12:30.

The board voted for Marisa's compensation package and Laurie will go over the evaluation with Marisa prior to the end of the month.
