### **Call to Order**

### **Partner and Staff Reports**

#### **NRCS Report**

Chris was absent. Kyle let the board know that there has been some funding approved through RT – 9. The team is working on which projects will be funded.

#### **Partner Biologist Report**

Kyle said that the contractors are meeting at the Antero Junction property, and work will begin in April. This is anticipated to be a six-week project. He submitted a \$26 million grant

through the USFS and the Community Wildlife Defense Grant. They will hear by June 1, 2025.

### **CSU Extension Report**

Darian reported that 4-H numbers were climbing. He will be offering a forestry workshop as well as a radon awareness class in the Spring. They offered a forestry academy on March 1, 2025. CSU has signed up for every third Farmer's Market. They will have themes for each day. He received a donation from El Pomar for 4-H. Darian let the board know that Barbie Garnett, CSU Park County Extension Director, has moved into a new position and both her position and the natural resource, 4-H position will be filled.

### **DM Report**

Rebecca made a motion to spend up to \$250/annually on software for the district computer due to the potential closing of the federal office. Greg seconded the motion. Motion carried. Marisa will investigate setting up a Google Voice number for times when she cannot be in the office.

### **Rachel's Update**

Rachel thanked the board for continuing her employment after the WLCC program ends on March 13, 2025. She gave an update on what she has been working on with the office partners. She will begin to work for the district starting March 17, 2025.

### **Old Business**

The board discussed what steps will be taken in the event of a government closure and/or building loss. Marisa and Rachel are getting rooms and TPCD supplies organized.

### **New Business**

Rebecca made a motion to cancel the 2025 election, Greg seconded. Motion carried. Marisa presented the board with the completed Exemption of Audit for 2024. Rebecca made a motion to accept the 2024 Exemption of Audit, Greg seconded. Motion carried. The board signed the audit and the accompanying resolution. Marisa will submit electronically. Laurie signed the 2025 MOU with Ark Valley Weeds.

## Supervisor Reports

Laurie: Laurie asked if Camp Rocky information was available. We will also work on getting a tarp put on the water trailer. Rebecca: N/A

Wendy: Wendy informed the board about some bills being worked on in the Colorado Legislature for the 2025 session. One deals with ADUs and one with STRs. There are also some local ordinances and issues that the TPCD will monitor.

Greg: Greg has been attending BOCC meetings. He gave updates on the County Fairgrounds. He also discussed Colorado's \$1.3 billion budget deficit and how that may affect local funding. He also attended a town hall with Brittany Pettersen and others, discussing support for laid-off Federal employees.
