The board would also like to explore possible revenue streams to fill in for lack of noxious weed program. This will be added to the February agenda; there may be a work session scheduled for this topic. Rain barrels were also mentioned as a fundraiser through the watershed. Laurie would like the new manager to explore grant opportunities. Expenses to keep on the radar: 1. Envirothon/Camp Rocky, 2. Fair auctions- Dave gave an update on auction process, it will stay the same for now. Others have expressed concern about how the prices are set. He stated that we should perhaps not participate next year to send a message. 3. College scholarships.

New Business: Officers were elected. Laurie suggested the board stay the same regarding officer positions. Greg made a motion to approve, Dave seconded. Motion carried. Laurie will remain president, Wendy is Vice-President, Rebecca is Secretary/Treasurer. Laurie booked the meeting room for the five candidate interviews on January 23rd, with the 30th as a back-up. Each candidate will have a 45-minute time slot with a 15 minute debrief in-between. Marisa was asked to attend either in-person or via phone/zoom. Laurie confirmed her availability.
